INSTRUCTIONS

1. Complete the AARCH Preservation Awards Nomination Form, which is available on our website: <https://www.aarch.org/preserve/aarch-awards/nominations/>
2. Attach a brief (one or two page) narrative supporting your nomination. Please include:
 - ◇ A description of the property or project, including specific location
 - ◇ Names of key persons involved, including those who performed the work
 - ◇ Historical background of the property, if known
 - ◇ Sources of funding used for the project.
3. Submit at least four (4) clear, color photographs of the project. *At least two photographs must show before and after conditions.*
